Hide Grade Totals

Canvas has many customizable features you may not be aware of, and many that will be brand new with the roll-out of the new gradebook (coming VERY soon!). Here's a useful feature that will work in the current and new gradebook.

Even if students can see their grades for individual assignments and assessments, you can opt to hide their grade totals. Just go into the course and click on Settings in the left-hand menu. Scroll down to the bottom of the Course Details page until you find "more options".
