

Essential Details for the OnBase-ACT Integration

This document provides information for employees who submit and approve ACT Documents.

What is Changing?

- Integrated Attachments within ACT: All attachments for ACT documents (outside of Auto-ACT) will now be submitted via OnBase and will be accessible to all approvers in the ACT approval path.
- **Sunset of ACT Attachment System:** With the new OnBase attachment process, the legacy ACT attachment system will be sunset.
- **Important Note:** ACT documents with missing supporting documentation or documents requiring revisions will be returned to the requestor to allow for corrected documentation to be uploaded.

Why the Change to OnBase-ACT Integration?

- **Improved Process with added features:** A single process for submitting supporting documentation while also making it accessible to all approvers in the workflow path.
- **Enhanced Review and Audit:** Allows for comprehensive review and audit of supporting documentation throughout the ACT document workflow.

Go-Live Date

• Target Date: The week of July 29.

Impacted Users and Access Control

- Affected Users: All Oracle HR & Finance users who submit and approve ACT documents.
- **Current Users:** Employees with Oracle HR Officer Responsibility and those listed in WAM as approvers for ACT documents will be granted access programmatically.
- New Access Requests & Controls: See table below.
