The Integrative Center for Aging Research (ICAR) is soliciting pilot project research proposals. The scope of this pilot call is broad by design; we will accept for consideration high quality competitive proposals from any topic related to aging — from basic biology of aging, to translational, clinical, and community-based research. Integrated, multidisciplinary, and translational approaches are encouraged. Applications are also encouraged that examine the relationship of aging and disease, and that explore interventions to promote function and independence for older adults living with serious and chronic illness and among vulnerable and under-resourced older adults in the Deep South. Intervention studies should address issues of intervention delivery and implementation science.

A panel of research experts will evaluate the proposals on a competitive manner with the following driving criteria:

- · Relevance/significance
- Innovation
- · Approach feasibility of the scope of work proposed
- · Potential for subsequent extramural funding

The pilot program will provide up to \$25,000 per award, prioritizing meritorious pilot projects from early stage investigators; however, established investigators seeking pilot funding to start a new innovative research line — that is significantly different from their current research work— will also be considered.
