2 Alabama Commission on Higher Education (ACHE) Academic Levels: Division of academic activity into four categories of instructional content designated as lower division and upper division undergraduate and graduate levels one and two. Note that these course level definitions apply to the instructional content of the academic activity not to the participant (student level).

Undergraduate Lower Division: Courses in lower division typically carry course numbers below 300.

Undergraduate Upper Division: Courses in upper division typically carry course numbers between 300 to 499.

Graduate Level One: Courses in Level One typically carry course numbers between 500 to 699. Courses in the School of Education with course numbers 700-729 are classified as Graduate One.

Graduate Level Two: Courses in Level Two typically carry course numbers above 700.

3 Dental Assisting Program courses taught for course credit in School of Dentistry.

4 Honors College credit hours do not include honors courses taught for course credit in the Honors College by other schools/college.

5 Includes courses taught in course departments of Clinical Dentistry and Oral Biology which are within the School of Dentistry.

7 Includes courses taught in course department of Vision Science within the School of Optometry.
