APPLICATION GUIDELINES FOR TRAINEE TRAVEL AWARDS

Application deadline for submission is February 7, 2025.

Applications should include the following in a single pdf file:

- Brief description of the opportunity and relationship to the trainee program of study
- One-page CV from the trainee
- Brief letter of endorsement from the mentor clearly stating how the student will benefit from participation and also that no other support is available
- Budget details, including registration fees
- If applicable/available, copy of abstract include letter of acceptance
- Virtual attendance is allowed, but if the application is for registration to an in- person travel event, the application must include an approved in-person travel form. Travel Pre-Approval Form
