#### CWRH NEJM Study Shows Treating Preexisting High Blood Pressure in Pregnancy Improves Maternal, Fetal Outcomes

A new study supported by the CWRH and published in The New England Journal of Medicine provides evidence that treating mild chronic hypertension with medication is beneficial and safe for moms and babies. The Chronic Hypertension and Pregnancy (CHAP) trial findings mark the first comprehensive, evidence-based data for treating non-severe forms of chronic hypertension during pregnancy.

Former director of the Center for Women's Reproductive Health and Charles E. Flowers Endowed Chair of the UAB Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Dr. Robert Goldenberg, has been recognized by the American Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology as a "Giant in Obstetrics and Gynecology." #### UAB OB/GYN Receives 2021 Roy M. Pitkin Award for CWRH-Supported Research





A large multidisciplinary team of UAB/CWRH investigators including Drs. M. Baskin, A. Battarbee, H. Budhwani, W. Carlo, B. Casey, G. Dutton, M. Fouad, B. Hildago, B. Lewis, P. Munter, I. Scarinci, J. Szychowski, C. Travers, V. Shukla, R. Sinkey, A. Subramaniam, A. Tita, and M. Wingate, along with investigators from Northwestern University, Ohio State University, University of Chapel Hill, and University of Pennsylvania constituted a collaborative network to respond to the "American Heart Association, Health Equity Research Network on Prevention of Hypertension" call for proposals. Proposals focused on disparities in maternal-infant health outcomes. The team's application included five projects (one per site) and a coordinating center at CWRH. Submitted 04/21/2022 for \$20 million over four years.

# **CWRH Community Service**

In February of 2022, UAB and the CWRH joined in a cooperative agreement with LifeSouth Cord Blood Bank to offer all eligible women delivering at UAB the opportunity to donate their umbilical cord blood for banking purposes to be used for transplants to treat cancers and other disorders. After consent, CWRH staff confirm eligibility and assist with acquisition and processing of donated blood.

LifeSouth Cord Blood Bank is a community-based public cord blood bank that collects and stores umbilical cord blood for the purpose of clinical cures and research. Since its inception, LifeSouth has provided cord blood units for transplant in 30 states and 19 countries.

In just over two months, UAB has donated more than 100 units of umbilical cord blood for analysis and possible banking. Thanks to the efforts of our UAB and CWRH teams, UAB is already the top donating hospital in the region.
