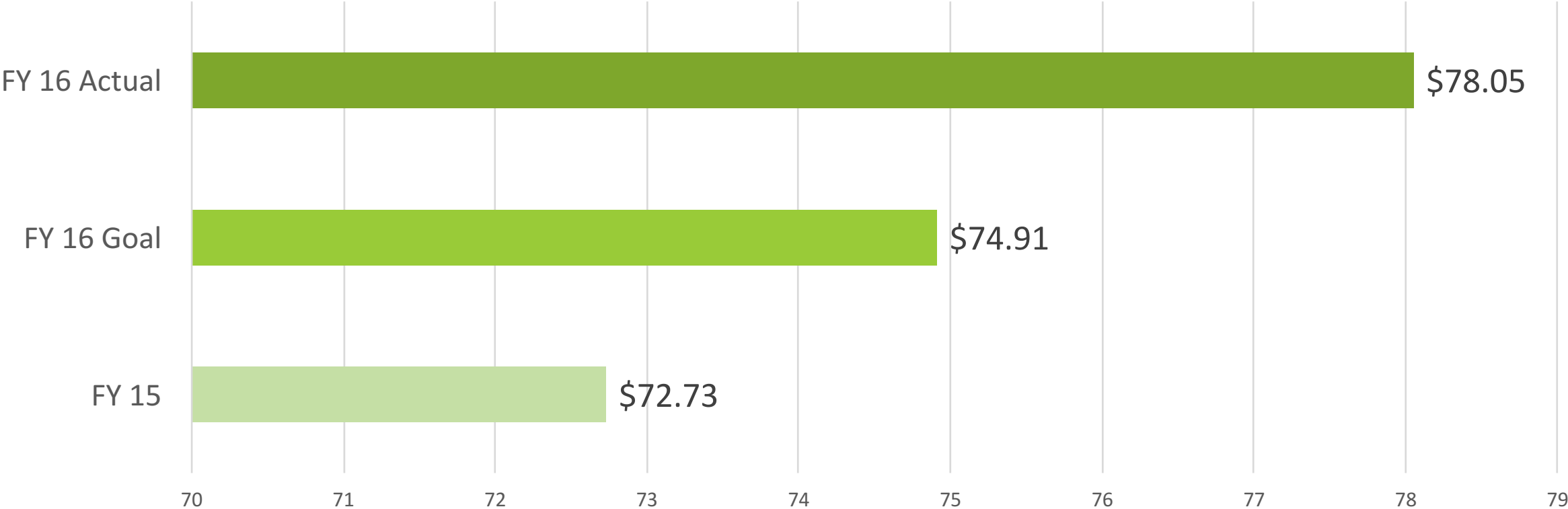




Annual Pulmonary Picnic – A Home Run for FUN!

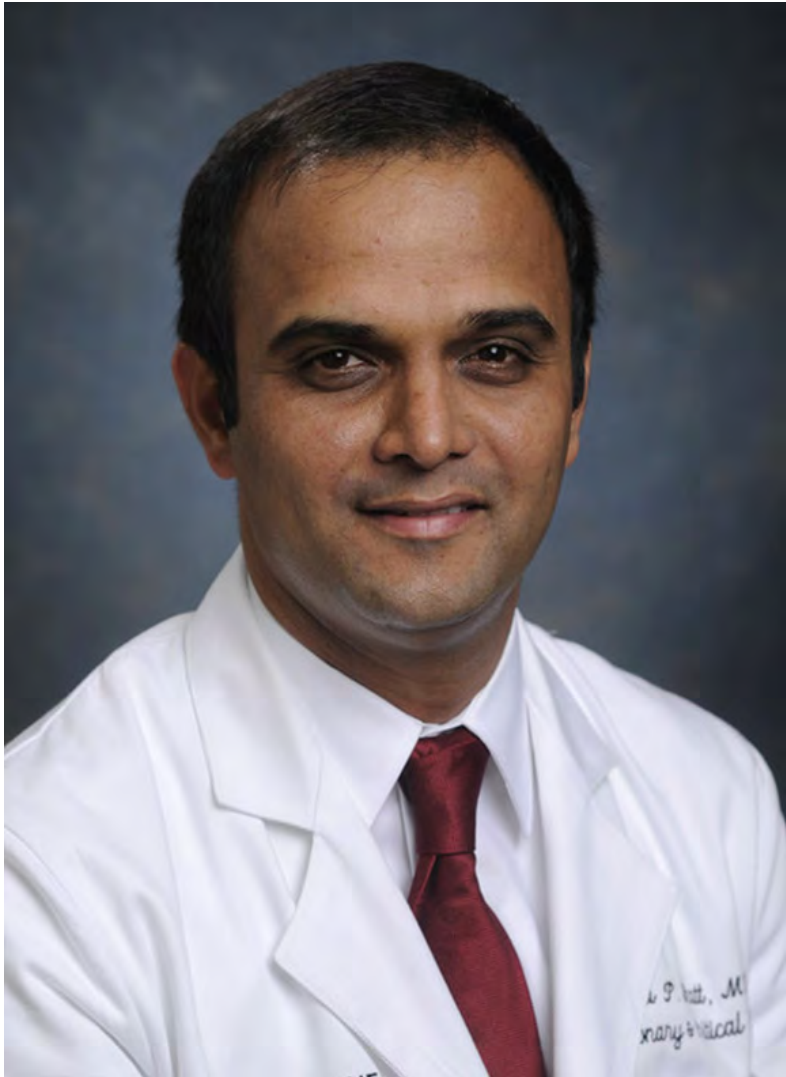
