### ABOUT THE RESEARCH TRAINING PROGRAM

- Training program open to rising sophomore undergraduate students at Alabama A&M University, Alabama State University, Oakwood University, Stillman College, Tuskegee University, and the University of Alabama at Birmingham
- Three-year program with intensive eight week **in-person mentored** summer research experience for year one and year two. h  
continued mentored research or internship
- Plus additional required learning \ opportunities and support throughout the academic year
- Opportunity to work with physicians and scientists on aging and health equity/disparities research
- Virtual seminars in Career Development, Scientific Writing, Research Education, and MCAT Prep
- Virtual Journal Club in the MSTEM areas (Medicine, Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics)
- Presentation of research poster at the UAB Summer Expo at the end of July
- Collaboration with students and faculty from partnering institutions & HBCUs throughout Alabama
- **Students will receive a \$3840 stipend per year throughout year one & year two, potentially year three**
- **Free housing at UAB for the two eight-week intensive in-person summer sessions**
- Applications for 2024 will go live November 1, 2023
- Letters of recommendation required
