

ABOUT RMS:

The overall objective of the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke (NINDS) Neuroscience Roadmap Scholars Program is to provide the necessary tools that will enhance engagement and retention of graduate trainees with diverse life experiences, perspectives and viewpoints in the neurosciences. The idea was based on the observation that many students deal with disparities that create roadblocks on their path to successful careers in the neurosciences. Interested and qualified graduate trainees are eligible for enrollment upon acceptance to the UAB Graduate School with emphasis on Neuroscience research.

This program is supported by the National Institutes of Health (NINDS R25 NS089463).

ELIGIBILITY:

Interested and qualified graduate trainees who have been accepted to the UAB Graduate School and are currently enrolled in a doctoral program with an emphasis on Neuroscience research are eligible for enrollment in the Roadmap Scholars Program. Students must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident from at least one of the groups described below:

- 1. Individuals who have faced challenging social, economic, educational, cultural, or other life circumstances (section A of the Notice of NIH's Interest in Diversity);
- 2. Students with disabilities (physical or mental) as defined in the <u>Americans with Disabilities</u> Act (section B of the Notice of NIH's Interest in Diversity);
- 3. Individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, defined as those who meet two or more of the criteria defined in section C of the <u>Notice of NIH's Interest in Diversity</u>.
