## Do you have Sickle Cell Trait or Do you know someone that has Sickle Cell Trait?

We are looking for participants for a research study to help us understand how to better care for people with sickle cell trait!

Who: Anyone (18 - 65) who knows they have or suspects that they have Sickle Cell Trait (SCT) and are willing to get tested to confirm their SCT status (we would provide the study-related test at no cost).

<u>What:</u> If you are confirmed to have SCT (finger prick test), you will participate and **3 short in-person study visits** (each 1 year apart). During each visit, you will fill out a questionnaire (15-20 min), get labs (blood/urine) and vital signs done at no cost.
