

REASONS TO REPORT

- 1. Disruptive Behavior** interferes with the living community or learning environment. Your prompt to report often reflects your frustration with a student's inability to adhere to generally-accepted expectations.
 - *Source of concern: HOW THEY ACT*
- 2. Disturbing Behavior** may not be disruptive, but it creates another kind of concern. Your prompt to report often reflects your unease, confusion, or discomfort with a student's actions, thoughts, or feelings.
 - *Source of concern: HOW YOU FEEL*
- 3. Distressing Behavior** reflects the student's impaired emotional well-being. Your prompt to report is when a student either appears to be struggling emotionally or discloses their personal struggle.
 - *Source of concern: HOW THEY FEEL*
