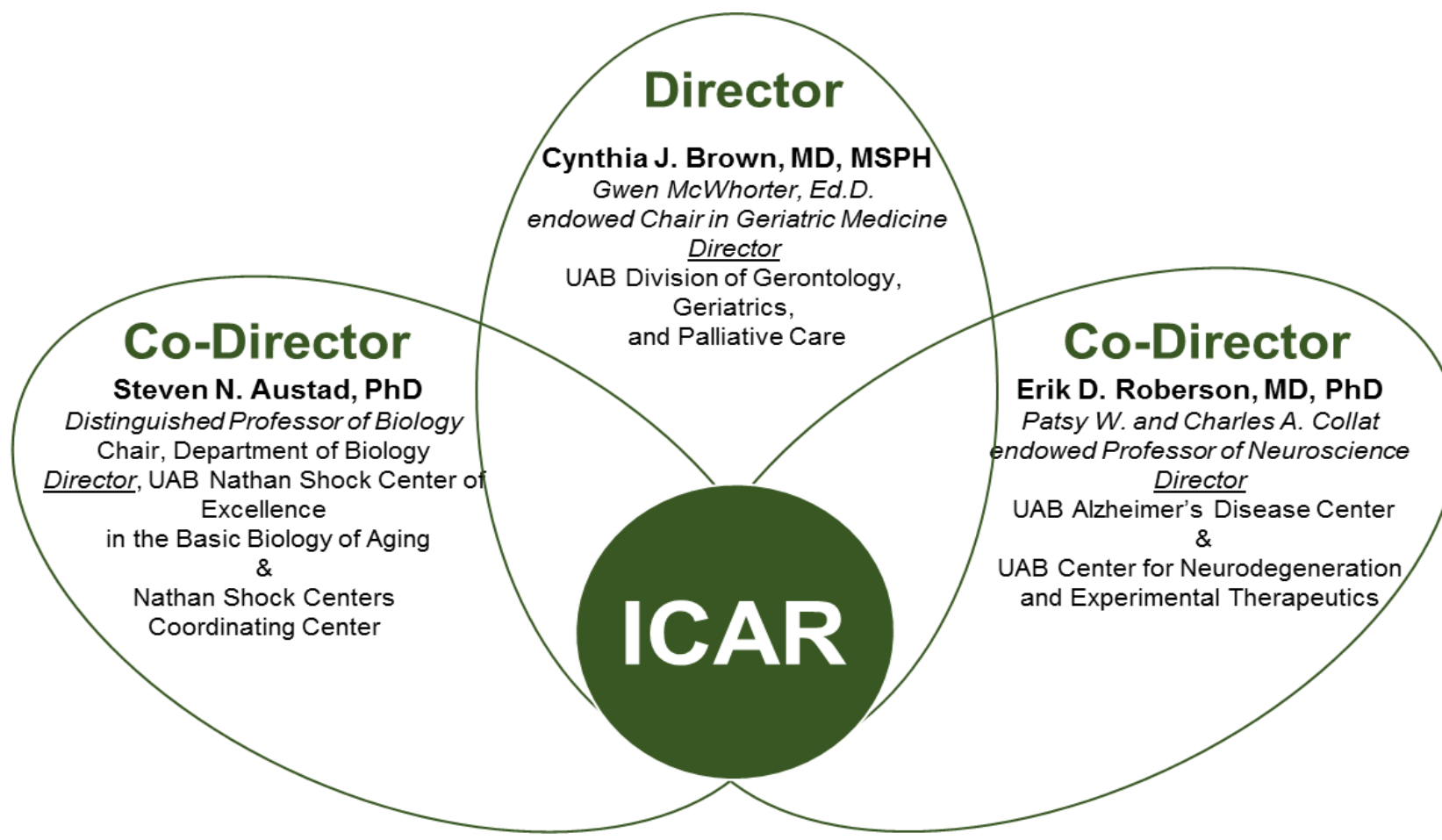


Moving towards integrating aging research at UAB from *Comprehensive* to *Integrative*

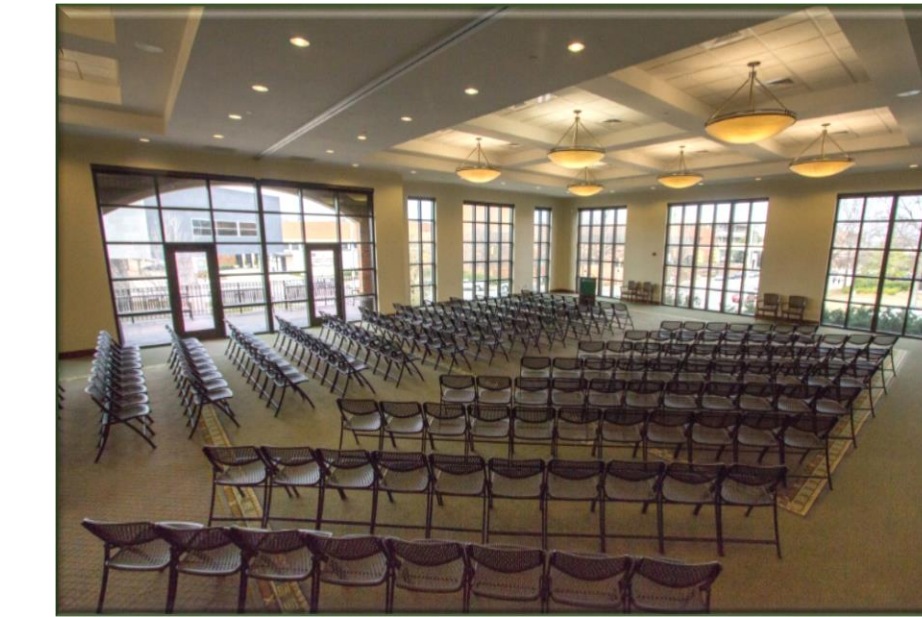

ICAR-Pilot Funding and Vouchers Program

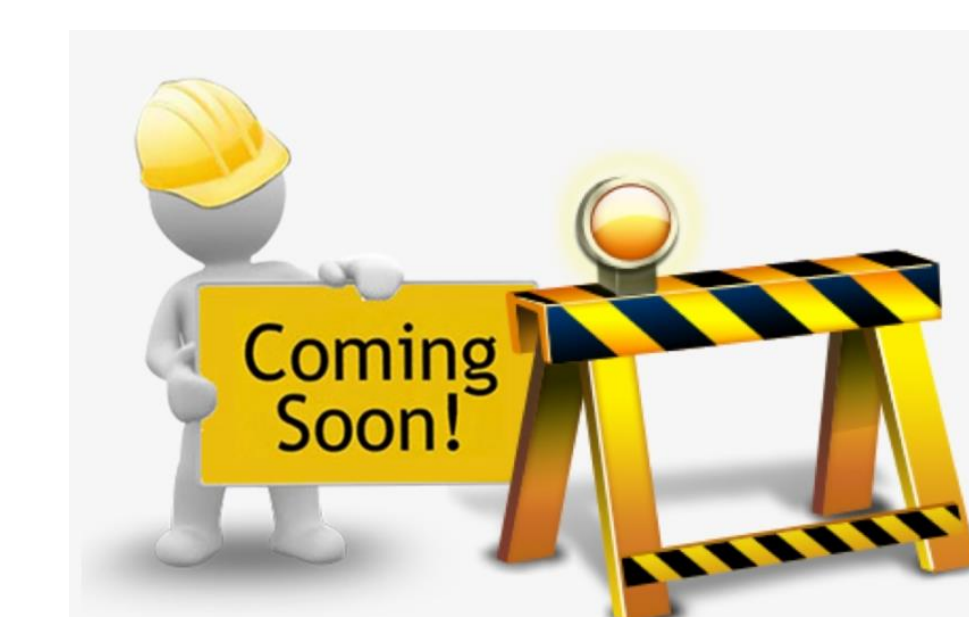
ICAR will provide multiple initiatives to promote the growth of aging research at UAB, foster collaboration, support new project development, and create a true pipeline for future growth.

- **Integrative aging pilot awards** — a central mechanism for submission to the specific themes of the Center (clinical/epidemiology, basic biology, Alzheimer's disease), and provide specific support to multi-disciplinary projects within aging research.
- **Research Voucher Program** — offered year-round to provide goal-oriented limited support for specific services, such as UAB lab cores and other central services focused on the development of pilot data for extramural grant applications
